SUBJECT AND VERB?

- The subject of a sentence is the noun (person, place or object) that performs an action!
- A verb (predicate) is the action itself!

Mark runs for the bus. The subject is singular.

S V



John and Charlotte go hand in hand. The subjects s v are plural.

Two nouns joined by and are treated as plural.

Jack or John is coming in later.S S V

Nouns separated by words like *or*, *nor*, *neither* or *either* are treated as singular.




Nouns that are always singular:

- Pants
- Scissors
- People
- Police etc

The scissors are on the table.

The police are on their way.



Collective nouns - plural or singular?

- Audience
- Team
- Class
- Family



The family goes to church every Sunday. (the family as a unit)

The family are eating breakfast. (the family as consisting of several people)
